Bloodline status currently unknown

***Ponte* Historical-Foundation bloodline** – placed under the care of Dee Perera, Boonville, MO in 1999; less than 10 high-percentage Ponte sheep currently located.

***New Zealand* bloodline** – Imported by Dee Perera, Boonville, MO in 2005, *Willowbank Marco*; last of semen used about 2015; young NZ offspring are producing in California, and a few grandsons remain still siring lambs throughout the US. The Alliance started to track NZ Karakuls in the US in 2020.



Karakul BLOODLINES Breeders

In our new [Registry Policy](#), Alliance Advisors designed an easy way to track NZ progeny in our population. When NZ influence is below 3%, sheep will then be counted as American Karakuls. KSAR will also internally track the 100% American Karakuls for The Livestock Conservancy.
