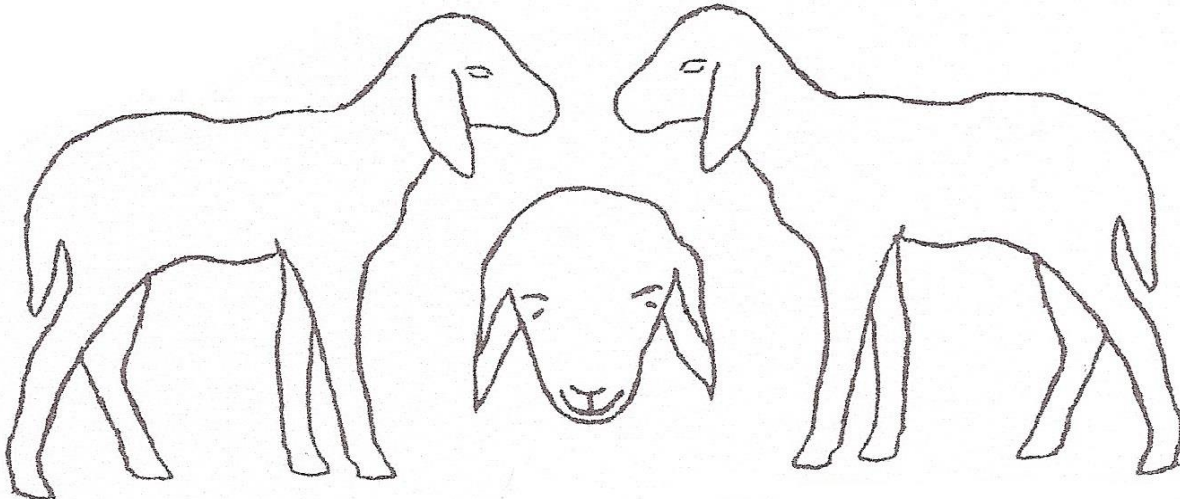

Please complete Section 1 Identifiers on the front of this application and submit photos of head, side, tail, and birth coat if a lamb, or birth coat(s) of progeny if an adult. The Registrar will discern identifying information directly from the photos and *Sketch Section*, with possible follow up questions.

REGISTRATION HELP & MUST HAVES

New breeders are encouraged to learn the terms by reading Registry documents, especially the *Standard of Perfection for adult sheep, The Karakul Handbook, talking with experienced breeders, and/or utilizing the Birth Coat Assessment and Barn Worksheet documents for evaluating lambs.*

The best *identifying* photos include head, tail and markings.

For applications from known flocks—a single photo per sheep is acceptable.

For new flocks, required—four photos including a headshot, the tail, side, and birth coat, or coat(s) of progeny.

Certificate transfers from other Karakul registries—must include a useable photo. If photo is too grainy for use on a new certificate, a current photo is usually required.
